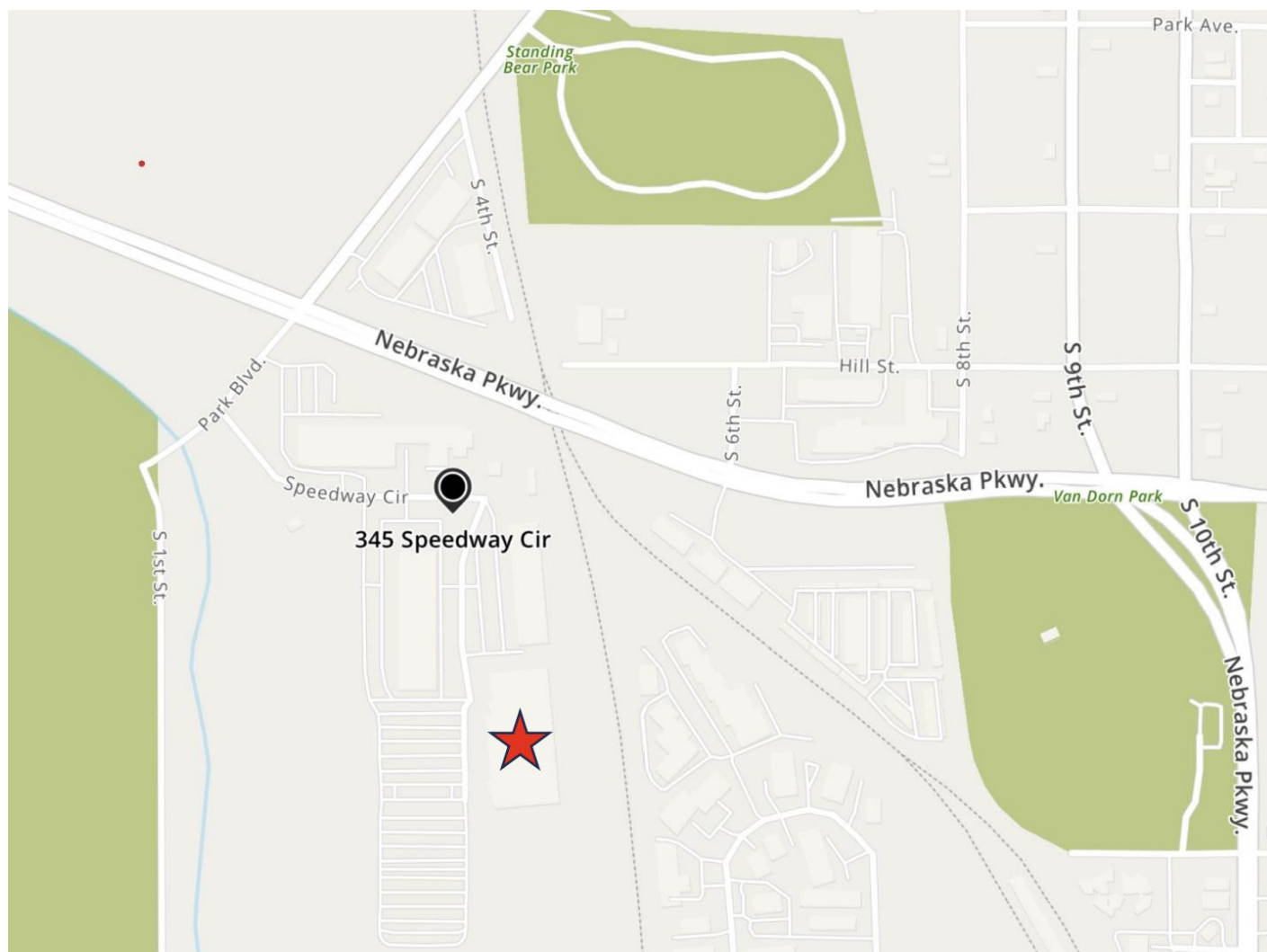


# Pre-Season Indoor Invitational

## Fieldhouse Fan Guide

**Location .** All Invitational matches are played inside the Fieldhouse located in west Lincoln at 345 Speedway Circle in Lincoln, NE 68502, within Speedway Sports Complex. There is one entrance / exit to the complex, positioned where South Street (Park Blvd.) and Van Dorn Street (Nebraska Pkwy.) meet. Refer to the map below. The Fieldhouse is the building denoted with a red star.



**Parking .** Fans can park anywhere in the lot to the west of the building. For the safety of all inside, parking in the fire lane is prohibited and vehicles parked there will be towed. The fire lane is clearly marked with a bright red curb.

**Entrance .** All Invitational directors, coaches, athletes, referees, and spectators will use the main Fieldhouse entrance, at the south end of the building. The Fieldhouse is equipped with a security system and other doors will alarm when opened. This traffic flow protects the safety of everyone using the Fieldhouse.

**Outside Food & Drink .** Outside food and drink is not allowed. You will be asked to throw away all outside food and drink before entering, so leave it in your car. Athletes can bring their own water or sports drinks with lids.

**Gate Fee .** Be prepared to pay the gate fee. Credit cards, debit cards, cash, and Apple Pay are accepted. Admission is \$10 per day for ages 12 and older, \$6 per day for children ages 3-11, and free for children ages 2 and under. Coaches and athletes receive free admission on their scheduled days of play.

**Etiquette .** Cheer loudly and have fun! Spectators must remain outside the perimeter net and off the turf at all times. Bleachers along the west side of the Fieldhouse and in the southwest corner of the upper mezzanine provide excellent viewing areas. Sideline chairs are permitted outside the field of play.

Please be mindful not to block others' views. Children ages 11 and under must be accompanied by an adult. Running in walkways, kicking balls against walls, or any other disruptive or disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated.

**Concessions .** The Fieldhouse concession stand will be open throughout the Invitational and will offer Coca-Cola products, sports drinks, fresh popcorn, candy, and other snacks. The Fieldhouse is licensed to serve alcohol.

**Code of Conduct .** All individuals participating in the Invitational – including directors, coaches, athletes, referees, and spectators – are expected to remain respectful and courteous to all stakeholders. Participants must follow directions from venue staff regarding Fieldhouse policies and emergency procedures. Violence, abusive language or behavior, obscene or indecent clothing, throwing objects onto the field of play; or causing property damage will not be tolerated. This Invitational is designed for children, and all attendees are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that reflects that.

**Did you know?** On January 1, 2024, management of the Speedway Sports Complex Fieldhouse and all outdoor soccer fields was assumed by a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation exclusively build to

- 1) Offer ethical administrative structure for the establishment and management of amateur youth sports teams,
- 2) Protect youth athletes and their families from exploitation,
- 3) Provide access to the best facilities and coaches for all amateur athletes at all levels, so that an athlete's Work Ethic alone determines whether s / he reaches their full potential, and
- 4) Promote the educational value of youth sports by connecting lessons in Competition, Sportsmanship, Teamwork, Resilience, Confidence, and Accountability to athletic success.

Profits earned from gate fees and concession stand sales are reinvested into our local amateur youth athletes, primarily by way of facility renovation and field development, and subsequently protecting access to those upgraded facilities.

**Fieldhouse Map .** Teams registered for 11 v 11 play will use the full length of the Fieldhouse, running north to south. Teams registered for 9 v 9 and 7 v 7 play will compete east to west, using the yellow field markings. Coaches and athletes will access the turf at the designated red star locations ; please keep these walkways clear at all times.
